Search Warrants in Goldendale:

Goldendale, Washington February 11th, 2013 – The Goldendale Police Department has been busy the past week conducting search warrants within the city.

On February 5th, the Goldendale Police Department in conjunction with the Klickitat County Sheriff's Office conducted a search warrant at 622 East Main Street on a Robbery Case. On February 2nd, Charles Foley took a man from the Dalles into the back bedroom of this residence and assaulted him with a wood board and took 40 dollars in cash and a necklace from him. The victim was able to escape and contacted the police. Charles Foley was arrested on February 5th. The charges for Robbery and Assault will be submitted to the prosecuting attorney this week.

On February 7th, the Goldendale Police Department conducted another search warrant at 500 South Klickitat Street for possession of stolen property. During this search, it's estimated that \$3000.00 dollars of stolen property was recovered. Items recovered were stolen hand tools, power tools, fishing pools and other miscellaneous property. As a result of this search warrant 4 thefts were solved within the city. Charges are being submitted on Roderick Huff, Susan Wideman, and Edwin Charge for possession of stolen property. Additional charges of vehicle prowling and trespass will also be submitted on Edwin Charge.
