RE: Memorandum of understanding and agreement for consulting services

GOAL

Assist staff, volunteers and management of the city of Goldendale with their efforts to prepare and activate a strategic plan intended to increase the utility, usefulness, and value of Goldendale Municipal Airport.

KEY COMPONENTS

- 1. Brief members of the Goldendale Municipal Airport Advisory Committee about airport management, airport development and airport planning in order to provide members with the capability to function on their own as an airport development resource to the city.
- 2. With the assistance of the committee, prepare and deliver a briefing to the Klickitat County Planning Department and Klickitat County Commissioners and staff about the city's intent to increase the value of Goldendale Municipal Airport to the economy of the city and Klickitat County. This briefing to be followed by a briefing detailing how the city plans to enhance the airport and what resources it may be in the county's best interests to employ.
- 3. Identify primary short-, medium-, and long-term projects and activities intended to increase the airport's utility and value to the Washington State airport system and to the city of Goldendale. Estimate project and activity costs, timing and sources of funding. Ensure that identified projects are reasonable and logical with respect to the size and use of the airport and likelihood of funding.
- 4. Brief the Washington State Department of Transportation's Aviation Division (WSDOT/Aviation) about this planning process, its outcome and justification for findings and conclusions.
- 5. Prepare a brief report containing findings conclusions and recommendations. Distribute a draft of the report. Finalize the report after community/county comments.

With respect to Item 1, prepare for and attend at least two meetings at the committee. Assist with organization and meeting conduct. Prepare and provide presentations about subjects that will empower the committee. Focus on county, state and federal authority, jurisdiction and funding resources. Explain airport

planning standards as they relate specifically to Goldendale Municipal Airport. Review WSDOT Aviation Division organization and authority and explain the state grant process as well as state-required reports.

With respect to Item 2, consider Klickitat County to be a potential funding source and partner in the airport's development. The first meeting with the county will be to explain the process the city intends to use to focus on airport development. A second meeting with the county will be to present proposals for monetary assistance if deemed appropriate.

With respect to Item 3, work with the committee to take a "big picture" approach to airport development and improvements keeping in mind that it is important to align airport size with community size and complexity. Consider elements such as safety, liability reduction, advancing aircraft technology/non-aircraft technology and sustainability of the airport.

TIMING

Activities described herein are to be conducted during a four month period beginning on or about the second week of February 2018.

DIVISION OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Airsafe shall subcontract with T-O Engineers for project engineering guidelines and estimated project costs. All fees paid to T-O Engineers shall be the responsibility of Airsafe. The city shall provide a volunteer or staff member to take and prepare notes of meetings.

COST/INVOICING

This project has a not-to-exceed total cost of \$10,000 for all services including subcontracted services. Airsafe's billing rate/travel rates are \$200/\$100 per hour respectively.

Direct expenses are billed at net plus one percent.

Airsafe's invoices shall be paid within 30 days of the billing date and will be delivered via e-mail.

INSURANCE

Airsafe has \$2M of general liability and \$1M of professional liability insurance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Goldendale City Council does hereby appoint Miland Walling of Goldendale, Washington to serve as the City of Goldendale's representative to the Columbia Gorge Housing authority. Appointment shall be for a three-year term effective immediately, expiring December 2021.
