Re: Agreement with Evergreen Rural Water of Washington on Smoke Testing

Evergreen Rural Water of Washington (ERWOW) is a non-profit agency the City works with that offers resources to public water and wastewater systems. They offer smoke testing on sewer mainlines at no cost but do require an agreement to be signed prior to this assistance.

The City has an excessive amount of stormwater that enters the sanitary sewer system. This water enters the pipe through cracks or connections that are not authorized but are very hard to find. Smoke testing (filling the mainline with smoke) shows these points of entry. When ground conditions are dry, the smoke will rise through the piping or ground and exit through the course the water takes to enter the pipe. This provides an easy way to locate the areas that need fixed or disconnected. We need to do this on every mainline in the City. The plan is to set aside two weeks every year to conduct smoke testing.

Attached are the contract forms, public notice and recommendations for smoke testing procedures.

I recommend approving an agreement with Evergreen Rural Water of Washington for smoke testing services.

SMOKE TESTING

AGREEMENT

I. RECITALS

- 1. ERWOW is a nonprofit corporation that provides training and technical assistance to water and wastewater systems throughout Washington State.
- 2. System provides water and wastewater services to residents of Goldendale, WA and desires to contract with ERWOW to receive Smoke Testing Services ("Services").
- 3. ERWOW wishes to provide these Services to System pursuant to this Agreement.
- 4. The Parties wish to enter into this Agreement to document their mutual understanding and agreement.

II. AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises, terms and conditions contained herein, ERWOW and System agree as follows:

- 1. **Agreement**. ERWOW shall provide the Services to System, described in Section 2 of this Agreement within the Term described in Section 4 of this Agreement, and pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 2. **Services provided by ERWOW**. The services provided by ERWOW shall include the provision of a smoke testing service to study the inflow and infiltration of the System and to detect leaks in the water and wastewater system of System (the "Services").
 - a. <u>Equipment</u>. ERWOW shall provide the equipment necessary to perform the Services, namely, the blower machine.
 - b. Personnel. ERWOW shall provide one person ("Circuit Rider") to conduct the Services.
- 3. Requirements of System. System is responsible and shall:
 - a. <u>Supplies</u>. System shall provide all liquid smoke, gasoline and other supplies necessary for ERWOW to utilize ERWOW's equipment to conduct the Services. System shall have a Safety Data Sheet for liquid smoke at the Property at all times during the Services. System shall also be responsible to provide safety equipment for use by its employees during the provision of Services.
 - b. <u>Personnel</u>. System shall provide no less than one (1) person ("Utility Operator") to be present during the provision of Services. The Utility Operator shall be responsible for taking notes and providing documentation/information to System. ERWOW will not provide a written report or documentation of findings to the System. It is System's sole responsibility to take notes and

document the findings of the Services conducted.

c. <u>Customer Notification</u>. System shall notify all of its customers prior to ERWOW commencing the Services. Exhibit A of this Agreement is a sample Public Notice ("Notice") that System may use to notify its customers. This Notice is attached purely for the benefit of System and ERWOW accepts no responsibility for the contents of the Notice or any actions or inactions that result from the use of such Notice. Further, ERWOW shall have no responsibility for notifying System's customers of the Services. System shall provide documentation to ERWOW one (1) day prior to the Term documenting that System has notified all customers according to this Section. If System fails to notify its customers, then ERWOW may, in its sole discretion, extend the Term by an amount of time sufficient to allow customer notification by System and proof of such customer notification is provided to ERWOW.

4.	Term.	The Services shall be performed by ERWOW on the following dates:		1/1/18 to 12/31/18		
	(the "Term").					

- 5. Location of Services to be Performed. The Services shall be performed at the following locations(s)

 City of Goldendale Right of Way and Sewer easement area (the "Property").
- 6. Grant of Access. System grants ERWOW and its agents, contractors, subcontractors and their employees a temporary non-exclusive right to enter onto and access the Property to perform the Services ("Right of Access"). If ERWOW is requested to enter onto private property to conduct the Services, System shall insure that the private property owners have approved the provision of the Services on their private property.
- 7. Fee for Services: ERWOW will perform the Services at no cost to the System.
- 8. **Limitation of Liability**. ERWOW shall not be responsible in the event that smoke enters a home or residence during the provision of the Services. Further, ERWOW shall not be responsible if any harm to System or System's sewer service equipment (including but not limited to: sewer collection system, pump stations and storm drains). System agrees to indemnify ERWOW pursuant to Section 9 below.
- 9. Indemnification by System. System hereby agrees to hold ERWOW harmless, and to defend, and indemnify ERWOW from and against all cost, loss, damage, claims, expense, and liability caused by or resulting from the provision of the Services, including any and all damage to property or injury to persons (including death), and fines, penalties, or other actions accessed or maintained by any regulatory agency. System agrees to maintain during the Term for its employees and ensure all contractors or subcontractors maintain: (i) workers' compensation insurance as required under the applicable laws of the state of Washington; (ii) employer's liability insurance with no less than the limits of coverage required by applicable law; and (iii) comprehensive public liability insurance in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000). Such comprehensive public liability insurance policy shall name ERWOW as an additional insured and provide no cancellation or coverage changes without at least ten (10) days prior written notice given to ERWOW. Certificates of all such insurance are to be delivered to ERWOW prior to the initial entry by ERWOW, or its contractors, employees and agents upon the Property to conduct the Services.
- 10. **Waiver or Modification**. The parties may waive, cancel, change, modify or amend this Agreement only through a writing signed by each party.
- 11. **Unenforceability**. If a Court finds any provision of this Agreement to be void and unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall be binding upon the parties.

- 12. **Applicable Law**. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Washington and any action regarding this Agreement shall be filed in Mason County Superior Court.
- 13. **Binding on Successors**. The provisions of this Agreement shall extend to, bind, and inure to the benefit of each of the parties and their respective heirs, personal representatives, successors, and permitted assigns.
- 14. Entire Agreement. This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, understandings and agreements
- 15. **Attorneys' Fees**. If any party to this Agreement institutes a suit against another party concerning this Agreement, the prevailing party is entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses (including any fees on appeal or through use of Alternative Dispute Resolution processes).

TO ALL OCCUPANTS AND RESIDENTS:

TO THE GOOD THE HEAD IN THE HE

TESTING WILL BE CONDUCTED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF

THE TESTING MAY INCLUDE BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:
RIOWING SMOKE INTO THE EXISTING SEWED COLLECTION SYSTEM (SEWED LINES)

- LOWING SMOKE INTO THE EXISTING SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM (SEWER LINES).
- ✓ THIS SMOKE WILL REVEAL SOURCES OF SEWER ODORS IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD, AS WELL AS PLACES WHERE STORM AND OTHER SURFACE WATERS MAY BE ENTERING THE SANITARY SYSTEM.
- ✓ A SPECIAL, NON-TOXIC SMOKE WILL BE USED IN THESE TESTS. THE SMOKE IS MANUFACTURED FOR THIS PURPOSE. IT LEAVES NO RESIDUALS OR STAINS AND HAS NO EFFECTS ON PLANT AND ANIMAL LIFE.
- ✓ THE SMOKE HAS A DISTINCTIVE, BUT NOT UNPLEASANT ODOR. VISIBILITY AND ODOR LAST ONLY A FEW MINUTES, WHERE THERE IS ADEQUATE VENTILATION.

BECAUSE THE PLUMBING APPLIANCES IN YOUR HOUSE OR BUILDING ARE CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM SOME OF THIS SMOKE MAY ENTER YOUR HOUSE IF THE:

- VENTS CONNECTED TO YOUR BUILDING'S SEWER PIPES ARE INADEQUATE, DEFECTIVE OR IMPROPERLY INSTALLED.
- TRAPS UNDER SINKS, TUBS, BASINS, SHOWERS AND OTHER DRAINS ARE DRY, DEFECTIVE, IMPROPERLY INSTALLED OR MISSING.
- PIPES, CONNECTIONS AND SEALS OF THE WASTEWATER DRAIN SYSTEM IN AND UNDER YOUR BUILDING ARE DAMAGED, DEFECTIVE, HAVE PLUGS MISSING OR ARE IMPROPERLY INSTALLED.

ALL RESIDENTS ARE ADVISED THAT IF TRACES OF THIS SMOKE OR ITS ODOR ENTERS YOUR HOUSE OR BUILDING, IT IS AN INDICATION THAT GASES AND ODORS FROM THE SEWER MAY ALSO ENTER THESE CAN BE BOTH UNPLEASANT AND DANGEROUS, AS WELL AS A HEALTH HAZARD TO THE OCCUPANTS. WHILE THE CITY WILL RENDER ALL POSSIBLE COOPERATION, THE CORRECTION OF ANY DEFECTS IN THE PIPES AND SEWER ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER THE SERVICES OF A PROFESSIONAL PLUMBER ARE ADVISED.

IF ANYONE IN YOUR HOME IS CONFINED TO BED OR HAS BREATHING OR RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS THAT MAY BE AGGRAVATED BY SMOKE ENTERING YOUR HOME PLEASE CONTACT OUR OFFICE. ALSO, IF YOU WILL BE AWAY DURING THE DAY AND HAVE PETS IN THE BUILDING IT WOULD BE ADVISABLE TO LEAVE A WINDOW PARTIALLY OPEN SO THAT ANY SMOKE WILL NOT ACCUMULATE AND FRIGHTEN THEM.

- 1. Notices to anyone in the smoke test area delivered no more than two days prior to test day.
- 2. Make contact to City Hall, Police, Fire Department, Dispatch, Hospitals, Medical Facilities, Schools and Businesses in the area.
- 3. Map of the area that's being tested (8 ½"x11" that can be written on).
- 4. Qualified help three total counting me is sufficient.
- 5. 4 to 5 approved traffic cones.
- 6. Liquid Smoke with S.D.S. sheet read and understood and available to customers.
- 7. 3 to 4 sand bags 2/3 full with efficient amount of rope for depth of manholes in test area, or sewer line plugs and air pump.
- 8. At least 1 gal. straight gas for smoker.
- 9. A city vehicle that can haul above needed equipment.

This is a list of items I feel you would want to do and have to conduct a smoke test on your sewer or storm system with in your City, I could have forgotten something so if you think we could do or have anything that would help us conduct the smoke test fill free to let me know.
