Re: Capital Outlay for CLA-VAL maintenance

The City's water system has 22 CLA-VAL valves. These valves need rebuilt with new gaskets and inspected for proper settings every 5 years. Each of these valves is critical for the operation of the system. We have scheduled for 6 valves this year. All these valves are at Basse well #1 and #2. This is an operation we can do but have not been able to get to with our public works crew.

The work also includes recommendations for improvements on the mountain springs control valve. We have not been able to maintain a reliable operation from this valve.

The estimate for this work is \$9,844.00.

I recommend approval of a capital outlay for \$9,844.00 with GC Systems, Inc.

Dear Mr. Enyeart:

Per our conversation you have six valves to be rebuilt at Basse Well 1 & Basse Well 2 this year, plus time for a trip to Springs Control Valve site. The cost for this work will be \$9,844.00. I am attaching the list valves for your review.

The rebuild consists of the cleaning of the main valve and pilot controls and the replacement of all the rubber parts. If any metal parts in the valves or pilot controls require replacement they will be billed over and above this quoted price.

If required, the city shall supply all equipment, additional personnel, and complete any documentation required to meet OSHA regulations for confined space entry as well as supplying any traffic revisions which may be necessary for work in public right-of-ways.
