RECITALS:

- A. Seller is the owner of certain real property in Klickitat County, Washington, more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference (the "Real Property" herein).
 - B. Purchaser desires to purchase the Real Property.

IN CONSIDERATION of the covenants herein contained and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. AGREEMENT TO SELL/PURCHASE; DESCRIPTION OF REAL PROPERTY:

Subject to the terms of this Agreement, Seller shall sell to Purchaser and Purchaser shall purchase from Seller the Real Property defined as follows:

1.1. **Real Property**: "Real Property" shall mean the land, together with easements, rights of way, privileges and benefits appurtenant thereto, more fully described in Exhibit "A." The parties authorize the Closing Agent to correct and conform the legal

description to the legal description identified on the preliminary commitment for title insurance ("title report" herein).

2. <u>PURCHASE PRICE; PAYMENT:</u>

2.1 The purchase price for the Real Property shall be Sixty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$60,000.00) and shall be paid in collected funds at closing.

3. **CONTINGENCIES:**

This Purchase and Sale Agreement is subject to the following conditions being satisfied on or before closing:

- Approval of the merger of the mutually agreeable northerly portion of the Real Property to the adjoining property to the north and the sale by Seller or assignment by Purchaser of such northerly portion to the owner of said adjoining property;
- 3.2 Completion by Purchaser of due diligence with respect to the real property including but not limited to site contamination and suitability evaluation by a competent engineering firm;
- 3.3 Securing financing for a building project;
- 3.4 Approval by the Purchaser's congregation to move forward;
- 3.5 Architectural design of a facility that meets the Purchaser's needs;
- 3.6 Approval by the City of Goldendale of zoning, permits, site plan, boundary adjustments or other land use approvals required for Purchaser's project; and
- 3.7 Approval by Northwest Nazarene District Advisory Board for the project. Satisfaction of these contingencies shall be at the sole expense of the Purchaser. Purchaser shall restore the Real Property to same condition existing prior to performing its due diligence. In the event that the Purchaser determines that these contingencies cannot be satisfied, Purchaser shall immediately notify Seller in writing and the parties shall execute a written termination of this Agreement.

4. **EARLY POSSESSION**:

Purchaser shall have possession of the Real Property upon closing.

5. <u>CONDITION OF TITLE AND TITLE INSURANCE</u>:

The status of Seller's title will be shown in a Title Report for a standard owner's coverage title insurance policy issued by Klickitat County Title Company, which Title Report will be ordered by Seller or Seller's agent immediately upon mutual acceptance of this Agreement. Seller will pay the cost for such policy. Said Title Report shall have attached photocopies of all documents shown as encumbrances to Seller's title. Title shall be free of all encumbrances or defects, except those approved by Purchaser, as set forth herein, and the following shall not be deemed encumbrances or defects: rights reserved in federal patents or state deeds; building or use restrictions general to the area, other than government platting and subdivision requirements; easements not inconsistent with Purchaser's intended use; and reserved oil and/or mining rights ("Permitted Exceptions"). Purchaser shall be considered to have accepted the condition of title unless Purchaser provides notice of specific written objections within ten (10) business days after Purchaser's receipt of the Title Report. Encumbrances to be discharged by Seller shall be paid from Seller's funds at Closing. If Seller is not able to provide insurable title in accordance with this Agreement and Purchaser does not waive such exceptions to coverage that are not part of the Permitted Exceptions, this Agreement shall terminate and be of no force or effect. Promptly following Closing, Seller shall provide to Purchaser at Seller's expense a policy of title insurance pursuant to the Title Report, insuring title to the Real Property subject only to the Permitted Exceptions and other exceptions set forth herein.

6. **INDEMNIFICATION**:

6.1. Indemnification By Purchaser: Purchaser shall hereby release, indemnify, hold harmless and defend Seller from all claims, demands, judgments, fines, penalties, damages, liabilities, losses, Environmental Costs and expenses of whatever kind or nature, including, without limitation, costs of cleanup and the reasonable fees of experts, consultants, and/or attorneys (hereafter collectively referred to as "Claims") relating to or arising out of any Environmental Law or Hazardous Substances at or with respect to the Real Property to the extent caused by Purchaser or caused by third parties other than Purchaser on or after Purchaser takes possession, including, without limitation, claims relating to or arising out of the following:

- 6.1.1. Except to the extent caused by Seller, the presence or release of Hazardous Substances at or from the Real Property after Purchaser takes possession;
- 6.1.2. The violation of any Environmental Laws caused by actions or inactions of Purchaser;
- 6.1.3. Purchaser's breach of any representation, covenant or obligation in this Agreement regarding Hazardous Substances or the Environmental Conditions of the Real Property; and
- 6.1.4. Except to the extent that the presence of such Hazardous Substances is caused by Seller, any claims for personal injury, property damage, or natural resource damage arising out of or related to the presence or release of any Hazardous Substances at or from the Real Property after Purchaser takes possession.

6.2. **Definitions:**

- 6.2.1. <u>Environmental Conditions</u> means conditions involving the presence of Hazardous Substances in soil, surface waters, groundwater, and sediments.
- 6.2.2. Environmental Costs means, without limitation, any actual or potential cleanup costs, remediation, removal, or other response costs (which, without limitation, shall include costs to cause the Real Property to come into compliance with Environmental Laws or any other agency or citizen suit actions), investigation costs (including without limitation, fees of consultants, legal counsel, and other experts in connection with any environmental investigation, liabilities, or obligations under any lease or other contract), payments, damages, penalties (including without limitation, any actual, punitive or consequential damages under any statutory laws, agency actions, common law cause of action, citizen suits, or contractual obligations, or otherwise, including without limitation, damages (a) of third parties for personal injury or property damage, or (b) to natural resources), civil or criminal fines or penalties, judgments and amounts paid in settlement arising out of or relating to or resulting from any Environmental Matter.
- 6.2.3. Environmental Law means, as amended from time to time, any local, state, federal, or foreign laws, rules, ordinances, regulations, applicable permits, and applicable orders now or hereafter enacted relating to (a) the protection of human health or the environmental, including the Clean Air Act, 42 USC

Section 7401, et seq.; the Clean Water Act (Federal Water Pollution Control Act), 33 USC Section 1251, et seq.; the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 USC Section 300f, et seq.; the Occupational Safety and Health Act, 29 USC Section 641, et seq.; the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act, 42 USC Section 11001 et seq.; the Toxic Substance Control Act, 15 USC Section 2601, et seq.; the Water Pollution Control Act, RCW 90.48, et seq.; the Dairy Nutrient Management Act, RCW 90.64, et seq.; the Hazardous Waste Management Statute, RCW 70.105D, et seq.; the Washington Toxic Substance control Act, RCW 70.105B, et seq.; and the Washington Clean Air Act, RCW 70.94, et seq. or (b) the use, storage, generation, production, treatment, emission, discharge, remediation, removal, or disposal of Hazardous Substances, including without limitation, the Federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, 42 USC Section 9601, et seq.; the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 41 USC Section 6901, et seq.; the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 USC Section 1801, et seg.; and the Washington Model Toxics Control Act, RCW 70.105D, et seq.

6.2.4. Hazardous Substances means:

- 6.2.4.1. Those substances included within the definitions of "hazardous substances", "hazardous materials", "toxic substances", "pollutants", or "solid wastes" in the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, 42 USC Section 6901, et seq.; the Federal Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, 42 USC Section 9601, et seq.; the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 USC Section 1801, et seq.; and the Toxic Substance Control Act, 15 USC Section 2601, et seq., and in the regulations promulgated pursuant to said laws, all as amended from time to time; and
- 6.2.4.2. Those substances defined as "pollutants", "dangerous wastes", "hazardous wastes", or as "hazardous substances" under the Federal Clean Water Act, 33 USC Section 1251, et seq., Water Pollution Control Act, RCW 90.48, et seq., the Dairy Nutrient Management Act, RCW 90.64, the Hazardous Waste Management Statute, RCW 70.104, et seq., the Washington

- Toxic Substance Control Act RCW 70.105B, et seq., the Washington Model Toxics Control Act, RCW 70.105D, et seq., the Washington Clean Air Act, RCW 70.94, et seq., the Toxic Substance Control Act, 15 USC Section 2601, et seq., and in the regulations promulgated pursuant to said laws, all as amended from time to time; and
- 6.2.4.3. Those substances listed in the United States Department of Transportation Table (49 CFR Part 172.101 and amendments thereto) or by the Environmental Protection Agency (or by any successor agency) as hazardous substances; and
- 6.2.4.4. Stormwater discharges regulated under any federal, state, or local law, ordinance or regulation relating to stormwater, including but not limited to the federal Clean Water Act, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, all as amended from time to time; and
- 6.2.4.5. Such other substances, materials, and wastes which are or become regulated under applicable local, state, or federal law, or the United States government, or which are classified as hazardous or toxic under federal, state, or local laws or regulations, all as amended from time to time; and
- 6.2.4.6. Any material, waste or substance which is (A) petroleum, (B) asbestos, (C) polychlorinated biphenyols, (D) designated as a "hazardous substance" pursuant to Section 311 of the federal Clean Water Act, 33 USC Section 1251, et seq. or listed pursuant to Section 307 of the Clean Water Act, (E) flammable explosives, (F) radioactive materials, (G) lead based paint, or (H) radon gas; and
- 6.2.4.7. Such other substances, materials, and wastes which are or become regulated under applicable local, state or federal law, or the United States government, or which are classified as hazardous or toxic under federal, state, or local laws or regulations, all as amended from time to time.
- 6.4. Purchaser acknowledges that Purchaser's purchase of the Real Property hereunder is solely on the basis of its own investigation of the physical condition and acreage of the Real Property, including the soils, water rights, and ground water conditions of the Real Property and its immediate environs, and further acknowledges that

Purchaser is not relying on any representations, oral or written, of Seller or any person acting on behalf of Sellers as to the same.

7. **DATE OF CLOSING:**

The date of Closing of this purchase and sale transaction shall be no later than **December 31**, **2019**. Closing shall occur in the office of Klickitat County Title Company, Goldendale, Washington, or at such other location as may prove expedient. The parties shall deposit with the Closing Agent all instruments and documents and monies necessary to complete the purchase and sale of the Real Property, which will include but may not be limited to an Excise Tax Affidavit, Statutory Warranty Deed, and Closing Escrow Instructions.

8. CLOSING COSTS:

- 8.1. Closing Escrow Fees: The parties shall share equally in the closing escrow fees.
- 8.2. **Real Estate Excise Tax**: Seller shall be responsible for payment of real estate excise tax, if any.
- 8.3. <u>Title Insurance</u>: Seller shall be responsible for payment of the title insurance premium in connection with this transaction for the Real Property.
- 8.4. Recording Fees: Each party shall pay one-half of all recording fees.
- 8.5. <u>Attorney Fees</u>: Each party shall pay its own attorney fees in connection with this transaction.
- 8.6. **Proration of Taxes**: All real and personal property taxes and assessments payable in the year of closing shall be prorated as of the date of Closing.

9. THIRD PARTY RIGHTS:

No party other than Purchaser and Seller, and their successors and assigns, shall have any right to enforce or rely upon this Agreement, which is binding upon and made solely for the benefit of said parties, their heirs, personal representatives, successors or assigns, and not for the benefit of any other party.

10. **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:**

There is no earnest money.

11. **GENERAL PROVISIONS**:

- 11.1. Notices: Notices under this Agreement shall be in writing and may be delivered (1) personally; (2) by U.S. mail, certified or registered; (3) by a nationally recognized overnight courier service; or (4) by facsimile transmission, if a facsimile number has been provided by the party receiving notice, with a copy to be sent by U.S. first class mail. Mailed notices shall be deemed effective on the third day after deposited as registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the other party at the address shown above. Couriered notices shall be deemed delivered when the courier's records indicate that delivery has occurred. Facsimile notices shall be effective when actually transmitted to the facsimile number provided. Either party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other.
- 11.2. Attorney's Fees: In the event of any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement, whether suit or other proceeding is commenced or not, and whether in mediation, arbitration, at trial, on appeal, in administrative proceedings or in bankruptcy (including without limitation any adversary proceeding or contested matter in any bankruptcy case), the prevailing party shall be entitled to its costs and expenses incurred, including reasonable attorney's fees.
- 11.3. <u>Documents</u>: Each party to this Agreement shall perform any and all acts and execute and deliver any and all documents as may be necessary and proper under the circumstances in order to accomplish the intents and purposes of this Agreement to carry out its provisions.
- 11.4. <u>Time of Essence</u>: Time is of the essence of each and every provision of this Agreement.
- 11.5. <u>Legal and Tax Implications</u>; <u>Role of Menke Jackson Beyer law firm</u>: This Agreement affects legal rights and obligations and will have tax implications. The parties recognize and acknowledge that each party has been represented by separate counsel during the negotiation of this Agreement. In particular, the Parties recognize and acknowledge that the Seller has been represented by Menke Jackson Beyer, LLP and that Purchaser have been represented by Randall | Danskin. P.S.
- 11.6. <u>Covenants of Cooperation</u>; <u>Best Efforts to Close</u>: The parties agree to cooperate with each other and to execute such additional documents and instruments, including escrow instructions, as may be reasonably required to consummate the transaction

contemplated hereby. The parties shall each use their best efforts to satisfy any expressed or implied condition precedent to closing. No party will unreasonably withhold any cooperation necessary to bring about the closing of the transaction contemplated hereby.

- 11.7. <u>Counterparts/Facsimile</u>: This Agreement may be executed simultaneously or in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Facsimile transmissions of any signed original document, and retransmissions of any signed facsimile transmissions, shall be the same as delivery of an original.
- 11.8. <u>Survival of agreements:</u> The representations, covenants, agreements, warranties and indemnifications of this Agreement shall survive closing, except as otherwise expressly stated.

12. **NO JOINT VENTURE**:

No party is the agent, partner, or joint venture partner of the other.

13. **ASSIGNABILITY**:

Except as specifically contemplated by Section 3.1 of this Agreement, neither party shall assign this Agreement, or any part thereof, without the prior written consent of the other party, which consent will not be unreasonably withheld. Neither this Agreement nor the real estate contract executed pursuant to this Agreement shall be assignable by operation of law.

14. WAIVER OF RECEIPT OF SELLER'S DISCLOSURE STATEMENT:

Purchaser hereby expressly waives receipt of the Seller's Disclosure Statement as provided in RCW 64.06.010(7). By waiving the receipt of the Seller's Disclosure Statement as provided in RCW 64.06.010(7), the Seller acknowledges that it would not have marked "Yes" to any of the questions in the Section entitled "Environmental".

15. NO REPRESENTATIONS.

The Real Property is being sold "as is." It is agreed that no representations have been made by or on behalf of Seller as to the value, condition, quality or boundaries of the Real Property, or that if any such representations have been made, they have not been relied upon by the Purchaser as an inducement to this purchase.

thence Southerly along said Westerly property line 200 feet, more or less, to a line that lies parallel and/or concentric with and 30 feet normally distant Northerly from said Railway Company's Main Track centerline as originally located;

thence Westerly along said parallel line 540.1 feet to the Westerlymost corner of said "John J. Golden" property;

thence Easterly along the South line of said "John J. Golden" property 942 feet, more or less, to the Southwest corner of said "Klickitat Valley Grain Growers, Inc." property;

thence Northerly along the West line of the last said property 230 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER WITH all that portion of said Railway Company's 60 foot wide Branch Line Property, being 30 feet wide on each side of said Railway Company's Main Track centerline as originally located and constructed upon, over and across Block 19 of Fairview Addition to the City of Goldendale, Washington and Blocks 1,2,6,7 and 8 of Brooks Addition to the City of Goldendale, Washington and upon, over and across Dunbar Street, Baker Street, Sentinel Avenue, Putman Avenue, Nesbitt Avenue and South High Avenue, bounded on the North by the North line of said Block 19 and bounded on the South by the North line of Block 5 of said Brooks Addition.

ORDINANCE NO. 1493

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1478 WHICH IS THE 2018 BUDGET, AND PROVIDING FOR INCREASED APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND, CITY STREETS FUND, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND, PUBLIC SAFETY RESERVE FUND AND THE WATER/SEWER FUND.

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to decrease and increase appropriations in several funds below or above the original estimates, and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding exists, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDENDALE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 1468 is hereby amended as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> The Current Expense Fund is increasing its appropriations in the amount of \$53,000 to cover increased costs voter registration and code enforcement services. Revenues to cover the increased appropriations will come from available cash reserves.

<u>Section 2:</u> The City Streets Fund is increasing its appropriations in the amount of \$15,000 to cover the retainage payments for the South Columbus Road project. Revenues to cover the increased appropriations will come from increased State shared revenues.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Economic Development Fund is increasing appropriations in the amount of \$2,000 to cover increased expenses for attorney services for preparation of real estate agreements. Revenues to cover the increased appropriations will come from available cash reserves.

<u>Section 4:</u> The Public Safety Reserve Fund is increasing appropriations in the amount of \$15,000 to cover increased expenses related to outfitting fire department equipment. Revenues to cover the increased appropriations will come from increased funds from the reimbursement on State Mob fires.

<u>Section 5:</u> The Water/Sewer Fund is increasing appropriations in the amount of \$52,000 to cover increased costs for operating supplies, increased overtime costs and SCADA repairs. Revenues to cover the increased appropriations will come from available cash reserves.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its publication according to law.
