The aeration basin at the WWTP has an excessive amount of grit (inorganic material). This material does not breakdown and impairs our treatment process. I am estimating an annual electrical cost of \$30,000 to mitigate for its presence in the basin. Removing this material will reduce electrical costs and will allow us to operate the plant as it was designed. We have recently modified the intake to allow us to keep new grit material from entering the plant, but it does remove any material already in the basin.

The RAS (Return Air System) line cycles the solids and liquids in the basin continuously. The proposed improvement would install a manhole in the RAS line to allow grit to settle out and then be removed from the system.

I recommend approving a capital outlay for a RAS Cleanout at the WWTP for an amount not to exceed \$30,000.






