Proposal	The Applicant is proposing to develop a subdivision consisting of forty-nine (49) lots, occurring in multiple phases. Phase 1 of the development proposal will include nineteen (19) lots, which consists of approximately 4.89 acres. The Applicant is also proposing to rezone the nineteen (19) lots from Single-Family Residential (R-1) to Two-Family Residential (R-2). In addition, the applicant is proposing to request a variance to the street width requirements from 32 feet wide to 24 feet wide and to phase in the installation of sidewalks as construction occurs.


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Goldendale Event Committee will conduct a Public Meeting via Zoom teleconferencing as follows:
